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

# Policy Development



## Policy Implementation

After the policy has been signed by the CISO, the Policy Team:

- Briefs the ISSM community on the new policy
- Prepares a memo for the CISO to send out to all employees and stakeholders
- Ensure the Intranet is updated with a link to the new policy
- All policies are reviewed annually for updates/changes, and after:
  - any new cybersecurity/information assurance legislation is passed
  - New Presidential Directives are published
  - OMB disseminates new policies
  - NIST develops new Special Publications

# Information Assurance Policy Working Group

## The Information Assurance Policy Working Group (IAPWG):

- The working group was founded in late 2011 as a way for Policy Officers and those with collateral duties for policy to share experiences, policies and best practices
- Meetings are held the second Tuesday of the month, once per quarter
- Members benefit from each others' experiences and ask the group questions to help them solve current problems in their agencies
- The working group will reach out to other Federal working groups to offer our assistance with policy-related issues
