The goal of the National Initiative for Cybersecurity Education (NICE) is to establish an operational, sustainable, and continually improving cybersecurity education program for the nation to use sound cyber practices that will enhance the nation’s security. The National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) is the lead agency for NICE.

The NIST NICE Workshop in September 2011 will be the second major planning workshop, following the Strategic Planning Workshop in August 2010.

You are invited to apply for travel reimbursement to attend the upcoming workshop. Approximately 25 scholarships for faculty and administrators from 2-year and 4-year colleges in the United States will be competitively awarded through this initiative. Your application must include a brief statement (maximum of 500 words), explaining your own and your institution’s experience and interest in cybersecurity education, as well as your reasons for wanting to attend this workshop. Applications from all institutions are encouraged, including those new to the cybersecurity education field. Please also indicate the dollar amount of your travel request.
