Access to the NIH Campus:

- Whether you come via Metro or drive, all visitors need a visitor's pass from the [NIH Gateway Center](#) (Building 66). Allow about 15-20 minutes to get your pass.

Metro Access (highly encouraged!): The Natcher Conference Center (Building 45) is located right next to the **Medical Center Metro Stop (Red Line)**. Exiting the Metro entrance, the Gateway Visitor's Center is directly in front of you.

Driving Access: Refer to the NIH Visitor Site for driving directions. For those arriving in vehicles, motorcycles or bicycles, you will enter the Gateway Center complex via NIH Gateway Drive directly off Wisconsin Avenue, Bethesda, MD. All visitors driving to FISSEA will then proceed to enter the underground parking facility (on the [map](#), the parking facility is identified as "MLP 11". After parking, visitors will come upstairs to enter the Visitor center to obtain their pass. The cost for parking is \$2 hour with a maximum of \$12 day. FISSEA has free parking vouchers that will be available on a first come-first serve basis. To get to the Natcher Center: From inside the Gateway Visitor Center, walk upstairs and exit the rear of the building. Exiting the door, you will see a clearly marked walking path to the Natcher Conference Center Building (Building 45). The walk takes about 2-3 minutes (the above maps are not to scale).
