

**Title of entry: VA Information Security

# Description of Entry:

**Senior leadership commitment to information security is vital to VA's ability to protect veteran data while providing world-class veteran care and services. The innovative folding cube job aid is an engaging tool that promotes information security awareness across an audience of VA executives, managers, and supervisors.**

**The cube presents information security processes, themes, and objectives in a visually appealing, durable, and interactive format. Recipients manipulate the cube faces in order to reveal nine security graphics: six exterior square graphics and three larger rectangular graphics that are revealed by folding and unfolding the cube. Due to its novel and tactile appeal, the folding cube grabs the attention of VA leaders and keeps it – and increases management awareness of key information security concepts such as Risk Management, the POA&M process flow, and security integration throughout the SDLC.**




