**Overview:** Come to our 10<sup>th</sup> free FISSEA workshop. Learn about and discuss the CIO Council initiative to develop an Information Systems Security Qualifications Matrix. This matrix will establish qualification levels for staff engaged in Information Systems Security work to ensure general consistency across the Federal government. The matrix, currently under development, will describe the competencies; suggested experience; and suggested education, training and development needed for successful performance of assignments by individuals (federal employee and contractor) responsible for federal information security.

Dagne Fulcher (recently retired program manager for information technology workforce development for the US Patent and Trademark Office and who also served as a special assistant to the Office of Personnel Management as a liaison on IT workforce topics, supporting the Chief Information Officers Council) will lead the workshop participants in an interactive discussion about this initiative. She is eager to receive feedback from federal agencies as to what constitutes important job-related information and what knowledge is critical to successful performance of a security role. Agency participation in the development of the matrix is crucial in order for it to meet the needs of the federal workforce.
