Registration Procedures and Directions:

Location

SEC Headquarters is located at 100 F Street, NE and is connected to Union Station. Head toward McDonald's, on the main level. There is an indoor catwalk, between McDonald's and "Gate L" that will take you to the building. Above the door to the catwalk is the name "Station Place". One level down is the guard station for check-in. Visitors will have to go through the metal detectors. SEC will have personnel available for escorting to the auditorium. Elevators are available for those who are not able to take the stairs one flight down. The meeting will be held in the SEC Auditorium on the Lower Level of the main building.

Parking is available at Union Station, but public transportation is preferable. The SEC is accessible using Metro (Red Line – Union Station), MARC and VRE.

Metro Riders – When exiting Metro, please head toward the Amtrak area to enter Union Station (front of the train for trains headed toward Silver Spring/Glenmont and rear of the train for trains headed toward Shady Grove/Grosvenor). When you enter Union Station from the Amtrak side, make your first left, and head toward McDonald's, then look for the catwalk entrance (see "Location" section).

MARC/VRE Riders – Enter Union Station through the main doors from the train platform. Make a left and head toward McDonald's, then look for the catwalk entrance (see "Location" section).

Registration

If you are planning to attend, please email Peggy Himes (peggy.himes@nist.gov) no later than **Friday, February 14, 2014**. Please confirm you are a US citizen. Attendance is limited to federal employees and their authorized support contractors. Please bring your federal identification. There is no cost to attend and food will not be provided.

SEC prepares visitor badges with photos for everyone visiting the facility, even if they are Federal government personnel. Visitors can submit photos, in advance, until February 12, to be processed faster through security. Visitors will still have to go through the metal detectors. If photos are not submitted in advance, the guards will do photos as part of the check-in process. For each visitor, they will need the first & last names and the name of the agency. If the visitor is a Federal contractor, they will need the name of the company.

The guidelines for the early photo submissions are as follows:

- 2x2 inches (51 x51 mm) in size
- Sized such that the head is between 1 inch and 13/8 inches (between 25 and 35 MM) from the bottom of the chin to the top of the head
- Photo taken within the last 6 months or reflect current appearance
- Taken in front of a plain white or off white background
- Taken in a full face view
- Neutral facial expression and both eyes open
