

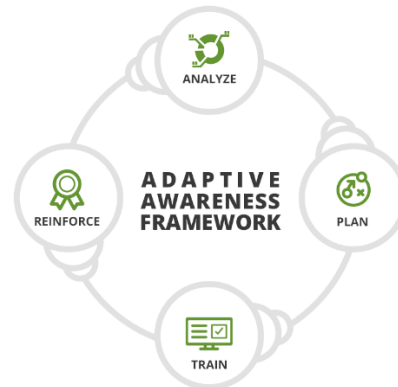
Adaptive Awareness Framework Resources
