NIST has been working to incorporate privacy risk management publications supporting FISMA



The goal of the tiger team was for NIST to better understand agency needs, gaps, challenges and successes on control implementation collaboration and to develop guidance or appropriate tools in support thereof.

Call for participation through the Federal CIO and CISO Councils and Federal Privacy Council; 65+ participants from civilian agencies, DOD and IC
