

How to attend a NIST PQC Seminars?

Since Verizon discontinued BlueJeans, we decided to switch to **Zoom for Government**, also called **ZoomGov**. On your side, everything will be the same as with the usual Zoom: you can join in the browser or with your usual **Zoom desktop application (we recommend this option for stability)**, and no need to have a Zoom account to join.
