
Adding New Algorithms

- Algorithm standards are just the beginning
- Modern security protocols are algorithm agile, but each protocol needs to be profiled to use each algorithm
- Innovative new algorithms may require the use of protocol extensions or support infrastructure to take advantage of unforeseen capabilities




Traditional S/MIME Encryption



1. Originator fetches the certificate
(or saves it from an earlier message)
2. Originator sends the encrypted message



IBE S/MIME Encryption

1. Originator fetches the IBE Public Parameters
2. Originator sends the encrypted message
3. Recipient fetches their IBE private key
