- Software License = \$3,238.13
- Storage Costs = \$0

Total = \$26,162.92

County Case Study #2

- 153,878 Registered Voters
- Full time Director & Deputy, 8 full time clerks
- Maintenance Fees = \$46,564.92
- Support Fees = \$26,375.00
- Software License = \$3,905.55
- Storage Costs = \$2,866.58

Total = \$79,711.50

County Case Study #3

- 564,429 Registered Voters
- Full time Director & Deputy, 40 full time clerks
- Maintenance Fees = \$32,274.13
- Support Fees = \$0
- Software License = \$297,739.44
- Storage Costs = \$120,418.55

Total = \$450,432.12

County Case Study #4

- 927,996 Registered Voters
- Full time Director & Deputy, 91 full time clerks
- Maintenance Fees = \$603,048.00
- Support Fees = \$94,500.00
- Software License = \$0
- Storage Costs = \$7,994.00
